Transportation is provided for students who are designated as "transported students" by the School District's Bussing Plan and who obey the rules and regulations established by the State of Oregon, the School District & Mid-Columbia Bus Co. Failure to follow the rules and regulations listed below could result in loss of bus riding privileges.

State of Oregon's Department of Education Rules Governing Pupils Riding School Buses

- 1. PUPILS BEING TRANSPORTED ARE UNDER TIIE AUTHORITY OF THE BUS DRIVER.
- 2. FIGHTING AND WRESTLING, OR BOISTEROUS ACTIVITY IS PROHIBITED ON THE BUS.
- 3. PUPILS SHALL USE THE EMERGENCY DOOR ONLY IN CASE OF EMERGENCY.
- 4. PUPILS SHALL BE ON TIME FOR THE BUS BOTH MORNING AND EVENING.
- 5. PUPILS SHALL NOT BRING ANIMALS, FIREARMS, WEAPONS, OR OTHER POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUSMATERIALS ON THE BUS.
- 6. PUPILS SHALL REMAIN SEATED WHILE THE BUS IS IN MOTION.
- 7. PUPILS MAY BE ASSIGNED SEATS BY THE BUS DRIVER.
- 8. WHEN NECESSARY TO CROSS THE ROAD, PUPILS SHALL CROSS IN FRONT OF THE BUS OR AS INSTRUCTED BY IBE BUS DRIVER.
- 9. PUPILS SHALL NOT EXTEND THIER HANDS, ARMS OR HEADS THROUGH THE BUS WINDOW.
- 10. PUPILS SHALL HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION TO LEAVE THE BUS OTHER THAN AT HOME OR SCHOOL.
- 11. PUPILS SHALL CONVERSE IN NORMAL TONES; LOUD OR VULGAR LANGUAGE IS PROHIBITED.
- 12. PUPILS SHALL NOT OPEN O R CLOSE WINDOWS WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE DRIVER.
- 13. PUPILS SHALL KEEP THE BUS CLEAN, AND MUST REFRAIN FROM DAMAGING IT.
- 14. PUPILS SHALL BE COURTEOUS TO THE DRIVER, TO FELLOW PUPILS AND PASSERS-BY.
- 15. PUPILS WHO REFUSE TO OBEY PROMPTLY THE DIRECTIONS OF THE DRIVER OR REFUSE TO OBEY REGULATIONS, MAY FORFEIT THEIR PRIVILEGE TO RIDE THE BUS.

For the safety and protection of your student(s), they will be allowed to get off the bus only at their assigned stop or at the school they regularly attend. (This rule can by waived with a signed written request by the parent and approved by the principal or his/her designee.) Please phone your child's school or send a written note ahead of time to the school offices to obtain a bus note for changes to your child's bus schedule. Changes involving an unregistered stop must be submitted at least 3 days prior to the date of change. Kindergarteners and Special Needs must be picked up at the bus stop by an adult. Older siblings designated to pick up. Kindergarteners and Special Needs must be 12 years of age or older, and parents MUST file a release form at Mid-Columbia Bus Co. in order for this to be allowed.
